Leaflets are available at the back of the church giving you ideas of what to put in your shoebox. There is also a box for donations for the shoeboxes such as: soaps, face cloths/sponges, toothbrushes, toothpaste, hats & gloves/mittens, colouring pencils, hair brushes/combs, sweets and appropriate toys (see leaflets).

How you can get involved:

- Fill your own shoe box
- Contribute to the 'fillers' (collection box at back of church)
- Donate money to help towards distribution costs (please place in the offering, marked 'Shoeboxes" or hand to me)
- Get knitting - we always run out of hats, scarves and gloves/mittens!
- Help at the processing centre at Central Church (see below)

Please, please encourage your family and friends to get involved too! The more shoeboxes we can send, the more lives will be touched and transformed. For every 10 shoeboxes sent, one child will commit their life to Christ.

The deadline for returning your filled shoebox to church is Sunday 19th November, when we will pray our shoeboxes on their way!

Processing the shoeboxes will take place on the following dates, so please do consider helping, as much or as little as you are able - every little helps! Even dropping in for an hour is worthwhile.

Tues 21st Nov - Fri 24th Nov: 9.30-4.30

Evening sessions will take place on Wed 15th, Thurs 16th, Tues 21st, Wed 22nd and Thurs 23rd November from 7.00-9.00pm

I will be doing a training session for volunteers on Wed 1st November at Upton Vale Baptist Church (Lymington Room - access from St Marychurch Road) from 7.30-8.30pm. If you are unable to attend this session but would still like to help, you can watch a training video on your first session of helping. Some of you may have helped previously having never done any training, but Operation Christmas Child is trying to bring consistency to the many processing centres and hence the need for training for all volunteers.
